Standardized Dress Code Policy

Shirts

Polo style, turtle neck, Oxford style, dress shirts or blouses – **any** solid color

Shirts may be either short or long sleeve and must be tucked in at all times. No visible brand names or writing.

For warmth, sweaters, sweat shirts, and vests may be worn over uniform shirts – any solid color, no brand names or writing of any kind. Franklin spirit sweatshirts may be worn any day. Jackets may not be worn in class.

Bottoms

Pants, shorts, skorts, jumpers, skirts, capri pants, navy blue, khaki, black, or brown.

Pants/shorts may be regular or cargo pants – not oversized or baggy.

Belts must be worn with pants or skirts that have belt loops.

Shorts, skirts, jumpers, skort length not too short – at least to the student's fingertips.

“Spirit Day” (Fridays)

Students may wear blue or black denim bottoms as long as they wear a “Ben Franklin” shirt. Regular dress code rules will apply. If a student does not wear a Franklin shirt, they must wear the regular uniform. Uniform bottoms can be worn with a spirit shirt.

Miscellaneous

Shoes, jackets, accessories – follow WFISD dress code.
